ESSAYS: 500 – 550 words Writer may mention people they know personally or someone they admire, but not fictional characters.

THIS BIBLE VERSE MUST APPEAR AS THE TITLE OF THE ESSAY:

"...be of one mind, sympathetic, loving toward one another, compassionate..." 1 Peter 3:8

Writer MUST: Select one or more of these topics, suggest acts of compassion, offer a positive solution

- **expectant mother & preborn child, and why student opposes abortion**
- **stem cell research, and why student opposes using human embryos**
- **terminally ill, physically or mentally challenged person, and why student opposes euthanasia or assisted suicide**



14 – 16 lines Students may choose their poetry style.

POEM TITLE MUST BE: **"...be of one mind, sympathetic, loving toward one another, compassionate..."** 1 Peter 3:8

Poet MUST express: Compassion and moral choices for one or more of these persons: **expectant mother and preborn child vs abortion adult stem cell research vs human embryo research**
terminally ill, or mentally or physically challenged vs euthanasia or assisted suicide
