THIS BIBLE VERSE MUST APPEAR WITHIN THE ART WORK; PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE ANY OTHERS:

"We must consider how to rouse one another to love and good works."

Hebrews 10:24

Students MUST depict only PEOPLE (not animals) AND "love and good works" to help them:

- * expectant mother & preborn child * those involved in the adoption process
- * physically or mentally challenged person of any age * terminally ill person



ONLY THIS BIBLE VERSE MUST APPEAR AS THE TITLE OF THE ESSAY OR POEM:

"We must consider how to rouse one another to love and good works." Hebrews 10:24

ESSAYS: Must Be 500 – 550 words Students may mention someone they know or read about.

- PLEASE APPLY THE BIBLE VERSE TO ONE OF THE TOPICS BELOW, AND WRITE ABOUT AT LEAST TWO OF THE STATEMENTS SHOWN WITH AN ASTERISK *
 - IF MENTIONING FACTS OR STATISTICS, PLEASE INDICATE THE SOURCE IN PARENTHESIS AFTER THE STATEMENT.
- ABORTION * Why it is a serious moral issue * Its negative effects on women/men and the value of post-abortion care
 - * The wonder of a baby's development in the womb * Define ultrasound and how it protects the preborn
 - * Unexpected pregnancy; the value of adoption * Programs offered by Womankind, Birthright, Care Net, etc.

STEM CELL RESEARCH * What stem cells are, where they are found, and why are they important * The moral difference between using adult vs embryonic stem cells in research * Successful stem cell treatments

ASSISTED SUICIDE AND EUTHANASIA * Explain these practices and how they violate God's law * Are either of them legal anywhere in the U.S., and particularly, in Ohio? * The value of the physically or medically challenged and how to assist them * What we can learn from the terminally ill, and how we can share God's love with them

POETRY: 14-16 lines; students may choose poetry style, for life-affirming poem. Choose from above topics/statements.
